The Long Island Sound Community Impact Fund (LISCIF) is a partnership among Restore America's Estuaries, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and the Long Island Sound Partnership. The purpose of LISCIF is to provide technical and financial assistance to communities for addressing environmental issues and to improve the quality and accessibility of the Long Island Sound.

For the 2026 Connecticut State Learning Exchange, the focus is on stewardship and access of communities in environmental projects connected to the Long Island Sound estuary and the Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan (CCMP) goals.
